Technical standards to be considered for your participation in the project and idea portal

Allocation:

Once again, this year's project and idea portal will be organised as a poster event. Projects will be subdivided into one of the following categories:

- 1) Consulting tools
 - a) with computer equipment
 - b) without computer equipment
- 2) Training courses/support for counsellors
 - a) methodological
 - b) professional

Please indicate for which one of the above-mentioned project categories you would like to apply by putting the relevant number and letter in the upper right corner of your poster.

Size and layout:

All posters must be created in upright format.

A 1-page print in A0 format (84.1 cm x 118.9 cm) is the only acceptable poster size.

You may choose between black and white or colour print.

Posters should be easy to read (type size, headlines, sections etc.) and should not be overloaded with information. Please structure your layout (e.g. title, author, introduction, contents, experiences, results etc.). Also remember to add your contact details and your personal picture.

Presentation

During performance of the project and idea portal a contact person shall be available for each project. He or she should be able to give detailed information. It is not permitted to use any other means of presentation (booklets, flyers, sticks, banners, audio/video material, etc.). Posters and details presented by the relevant author of the project will be the only factors considered for evaluation.

Further procedures:

We will print your ideas on high-gloss paper and place them on a weatherproof movable wall set up in the inner courtyard of the conference building. All presenters will be responsible for giving additional information. (There will be no further equipment, such as tables, laptops, beamers...)

Award ceremony:

A Jury consisting of renowned representatives of the Agricultural Chamber of North Rhine-Westphalia, IALB and EUFRAS will select the most innovative and promising project under each category. The award ceremony will take place during the closing event.
